-- No bus transportation will be provided.

-- Students applying to Merrol Hyde Magnet School will be given an entrance exam.

Applicants must score 85% or higher in reading, math, and language on the exam.

Copies of the last 1 ½ years report cards must be submitted with the application for grades 6 – 12. Students must have a B average or above.

-- Merrol Hyde Magnet School is an **Academic Magnet School** focused on advanced academic achievement. Students will be assigned projects and summer reading.

-- Students at Merrol Hyde Magnet School are required to wear a uniform.

Students in grades 7 - 12 are required to participate in a school sport.

-- Testing dates for students applying for grades K – 12 will be:
